An opportunity to save lives

Each year, three to four million pets are euthanized in animal shelters simply because they do not have a home. Incredibly, some regions of the country still have euthanasia rates as high as 85 percent.

In other parts of the country spay/neuter programs have nearly eliminated the overpopulation problem thereby creating a demand for more adoptable dogs. As a result, we recognized an important opportunity for us to bring homeless dogs and loving families together.

The Rescue Waggin' program was created by PetSmart Charities to help save the lives of homeless dogs and puppies through partnership and collaboration with local animal welfare agencies. The Rescue Waggin' is a pet transport program that transports dogs from areas of high pet overpopulation (where they face almost certain euthanasia) to shelters in areas where adoptable dogs are in demand. This program operates under professionally-developed industry standards for source and receiving shelters, spay/neuter and animal health practices, and humane transport.

How Rescue Waggin' works

- Specially-designed vehicles comfortably, safely and humanely transport dogs and puppies from overcrowded shelters to regions where adoptable pets are in demand.
- Drivers and transport coordinators are trained in pet care and animal first aid.
- Destination shelters are chosen based upon excellent adoption practices and available shelter space.
- All pets transported are spayed/neutered prior to adoption.
- Dogs in the destination shelters are not displaced to make room for transported dogs.
- Grants are available for overpopulated shelters in order to support high volume spay/neuter clinics.
