



Guidelines for Requesting Assistance for a Recent* Multiple Companion Animal Rescue of 25 or More from One Rescue*

(for animal welfare 501(c)3 nonprofit public charities and/or government tribal entities)

- Submit your Federal IRS employment identification number (EIN#) or registered charity # if Canadian
- Submit an article from the newspaper that describes the incident and states your organization is the assisting agency for the rescue and/or include a governmental agency letter that verifies that your agency has been requested to assist the pet victims.
- Include description about the incident and the exact number of pets your organization is aiding.
- Complete budget sheet for grant funding for spay/neuter and/or other medical expenses.
- List the pet supply that is urgently needed and indicate the closest PetSmart store(s) to your agency. The Manager of Emergency Grants will find out if the store's inventory level is high enough for PetSmart Charities to authorize a donation of the product. Do not request supplies directly from store.
- If a cash grant is awarded, your organization must submit an Emergency Relief Grant Follow-Up Report within 90 days of the grant award documenting how the funds were expended.
